

## Policy regarding groups larger than 4 golfers

1. The Board encourages foursomes or less.
2. All groups must have one club member playing in the group. The club member will be held responsible for the group.
3. Groups larger than 4 players are **required** to sign at the clubhouse in advance of the round. The names of all players involved said group are to be written on the special sign in sheet at the counter. Groups must register again after every 9 holes.
4. Groups larger than 4 players are responsible for their speed of play and must yield to faster players.
5. Couples wishing play in group of 4 couples will only be allowed to have 4 balls in play at a time, meaning, they must play a 2-ball, alternating shot format from the tees. One tee shot per couple per hole.
6. Couples wishing to play in a group of 3 couples will be allowed to play the standard 2-ball format given the limited times that more than 4 balls are in play.
7. Groups wishing to play a Best Shot format should keep the groups to 6 players or less, no more than 6 players (1 group) per tee. This should only be considered when the course is not busy due to the larger number of balls in play.
8. Clubhouse Management, Grounds Staff & Board of Directors have final say on course activity. If a group is asked to break up to speed up play they will do so immediately, without question.
9. Slower players must allow faster players to play through immediately.
10. Common Sense: If you are considering any of the above options, and you think the course may be too busy to play, please refer to Rule #1. Any questions regarding other course rules please refer to the Course Rules section of your Clubhouse Manual.
